

2. Folding state of cover






Connect section A & B of the left and right side rails seperately. (If the side rails are integral, skip this step)

Splicing & assembling the two ends of the retrofit bar




STEP 2

Place the left and right side rails against the upper and inner sides of the wagon, respectively, with the front part flush with the front side of the wagon.




Flush with the interior to ensure that the retrofit bar is vertical






STEP 3


Take out the clips, screws, wrenches, and handles from the accessory box to install them.

Schematic assembly of truncated retrofit rods




Pre-tighten the screws first so that the side rails fit snugly against the wagon, and then tighten them after all the clips have been installed.




Position the cover plate onto the truck bed, aligning its front edge with the rail cross plate while ensuring both sides are evenly flush with the truck bed. Secure the front rail by fastening the combination screws tightly.

NOTE: To prevent damage caused by handling the hood, this installation procedure can be done with the assistance of two people.


1. Align the cover plate horizontally in the center, and snap the front rail into the slot on the cross plate.




3. Adjust the cover plate left and right to see if the holes are aligned




2. Turn out the rubber strip under the front rail and wrap it around the truck bed.




4. Pre-tighten the bolts



5. Spread the cover horizontally and centered to ensure that each lock is working properly.




7. Install the included drain hose to the front of the side beam and push the drain hose to the outside of the bottom.




6. Tighten the bolts

8. Close the cover, then close the tailgate



NOTE: Different brands use different shaped clamps.

- Install pad "a" into the stake holes in the side using an allen key while placing the pad through the holes to hold place.
- Insert the hexagonal screw "c" into the screw hole and tighten with a 5mm wrench.
- 3. Repeat Steps 1 & 2 on both sides.
